"Resolved that the division of lands between the Government and the widow and heirs of William Pitt Leleiohoku, deceased, this day submitted to the King and Privy Council be, and is hereby approved: and that the Minister of the Interior be, and is hereby authorized to grant a Royal Patent or Patents to Luka Keelikolani, the widow of the said Leleiohoku for such lands as may be apportioned to her as her dower in the estate of the said Leleiohoku, and also to grant a Royal Patent or Patents to John Pitt

Kinau, the son and heir of the said Leleiohoku for such lands as may be assigned to him as his portion of said estate: Provided however, that nothing in this resolution shall be construed as interfering with the rights of the Land Commission to settle all disputes that may exist as to the title or bounds of any of said lands; and further provided, that nothing therein contained shall be construed as interfering with the rights of native tenants in said lands."
