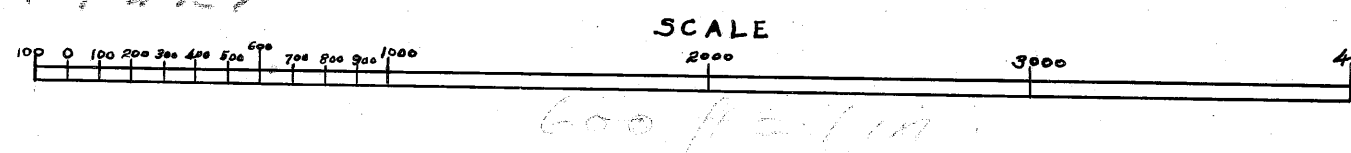

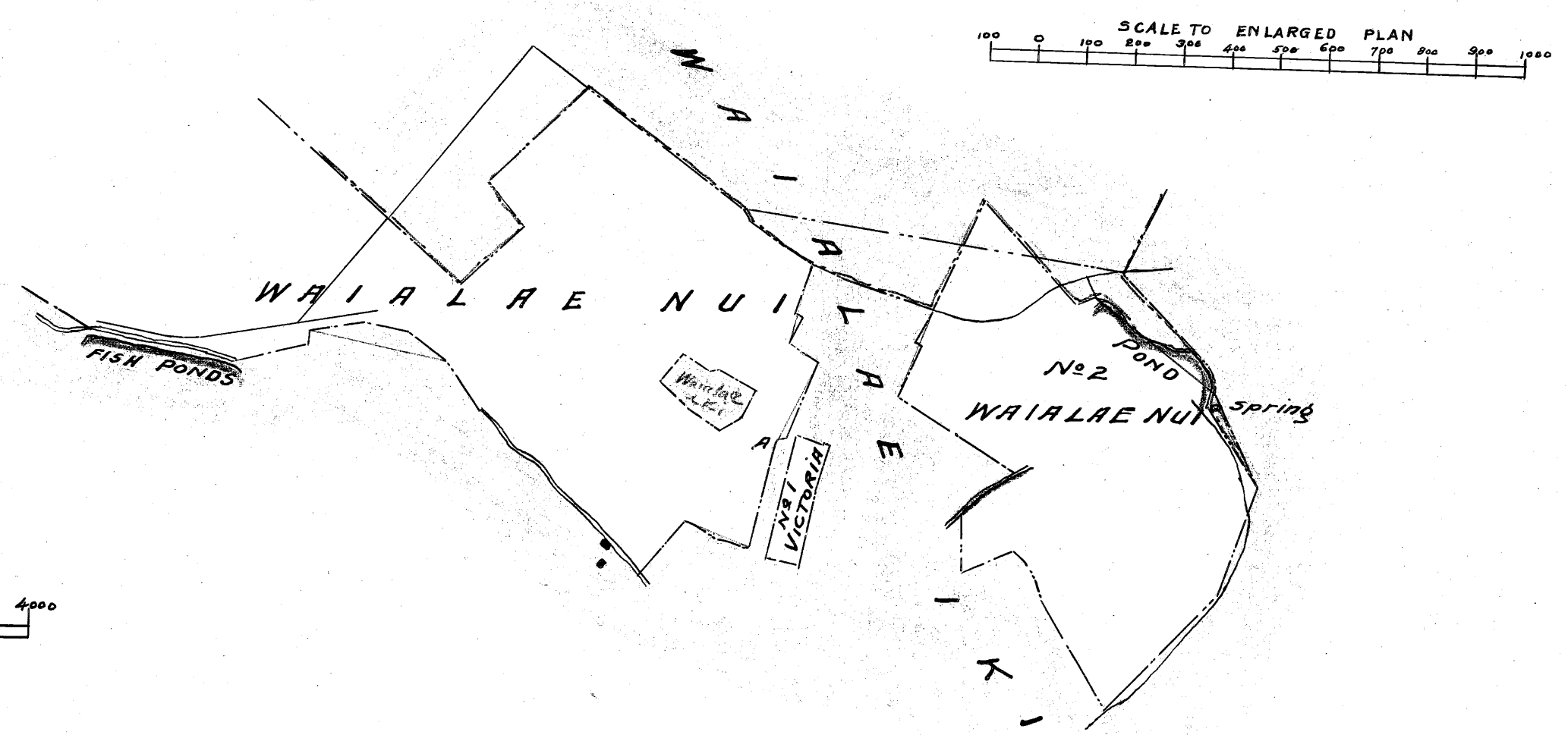

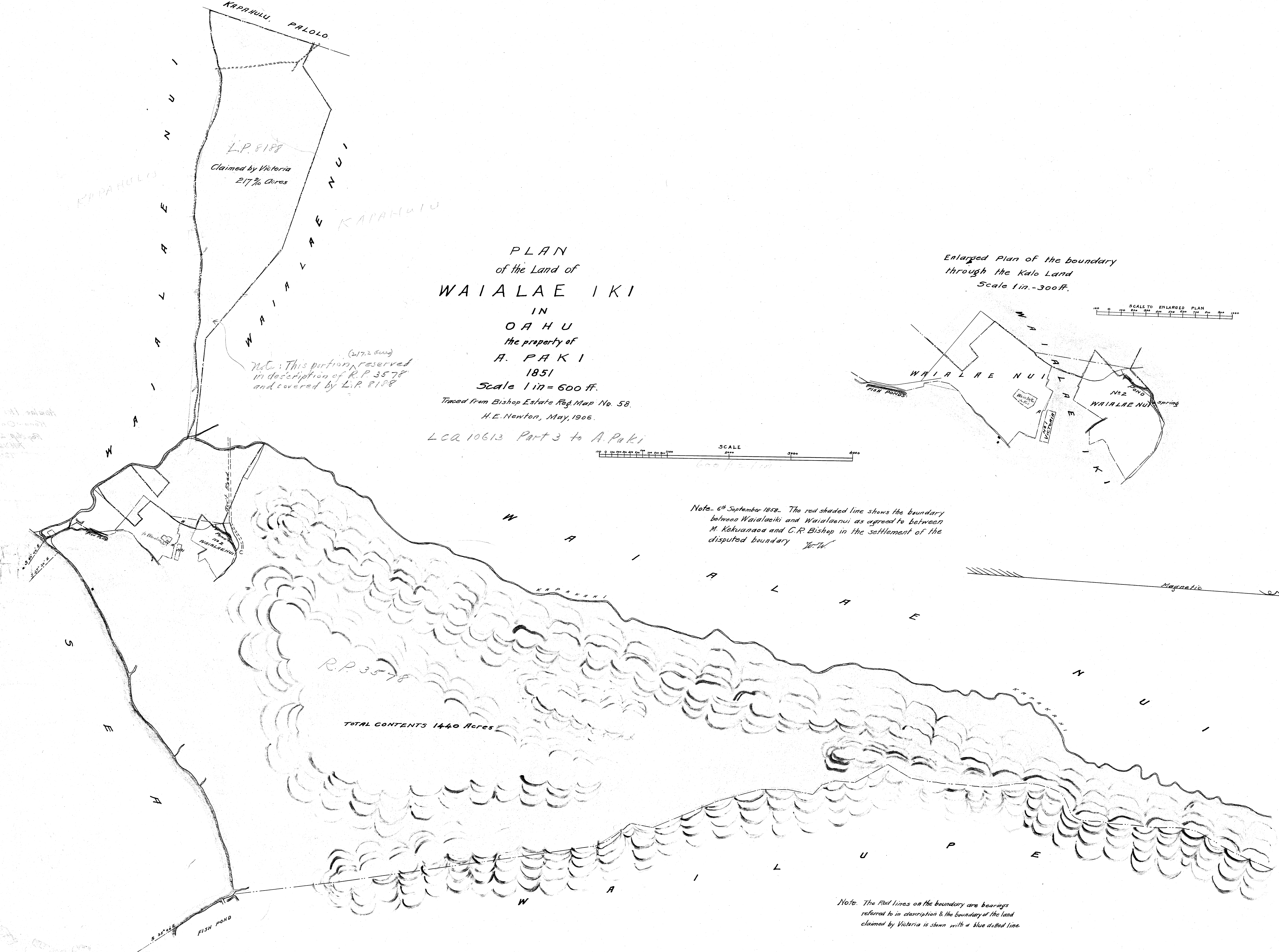


Enlarged Plan of the boundary
